The **aim** of this collaboration is to promote **research**, **training and documentation** in the field of forensic medicine, medical liability and clinical safety, in order to bring us closer to current affairs and challenges in this health arena, thus contributing to improving the health and quality of life of the population. To this end, we will work on the development of a series of activities involving agreements with different national and international institutions, focused on **supporting teaching and training** in specific degrees related to this field.

In addition to the commitment to training, **research** will be encouraged through grants and collaborations with external entities and **knowledge transfer** will be promoted through conferences, talks, publications and research and informative articles which,



together with the collaboration with other entities in the medical sector, will help to create a model of influence and leadership in this medical speciality.

## A Chair with a mission and values

Like Relyens, this Chair has a mission and revolves around a series of **values** on which it is based to convey the philosophy of its creators and transmit a clear vision of its commitments. The strategic alliance with the UB and Hospital Clínic is also included in the principles and values that inspire the Board of the College of Doctors of Catalonia*".
